

Committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, are you going to take the amendments? Okay.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the committee amendment. All it does is correct the spelling of the word "Eppley".

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, members of the body, all the bill does is correct an error that was made, an omission from last year's budget bill. It was typically worded last year, but one of the departments has asked for an Attorney General's Opinion that says, in essence, we have to specifically appropriate the...have language in it to specifically appropriate, and that language was left out in error. All this does is correct that error. It does not appropriate any new money or anything like that, it is just correcting the appropriation from last year. I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the bill? If not, the question is, shall the bill be advanced? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 152 advances. LB 323.

CLERK: (Read title.) The bill was read on January 17 of this year. It was referred to the Judiciary Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Judiciary Committee amendments pending.
