SENATOR HANNIBAL: No, Senator Higgins, it is not in the Journal. We just finally got...my legislative aide has been ill the last two days and hasn't had a chance to get together with (interruption)...

SENATOR HIGGINS: Did you pass a copy of it out?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: I beg your pardon.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Have you passed a copy of it out?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: No, we haven't because it is very simple. It just says strike the written matter on one page, that is page 2 in the bill, and there is only two words in Section 2...

SENATOR HIGGINS: Section 2?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Well, it is paragraph 2, Section 1, paragraph 2, there is two words in there, "management" and "managing" that are underlined. That is the new matter.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Right.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: And we are striking those two words. That is all that we are doing.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment to LB 109. All those in favor say aye...we need a machine vote, okay. Machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote
