

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please return to your seats and record your presence. We are only lacking Senator Vickers. So please record your presence, ladies and gentlemen. Senator Haberman, record your presence, please. Senator Nelson, record your presence, please. Senator Labedz, Senator Pirsch. We are looking for Senator Vickers and Senator Pirsch. We are waiting for Senator Pirsch. Okay, everyone is here. Senator DeCamp asked for a roll call vote. Proceed, Mr. Clerk. For those who were out of the room, we are voting on the DeCamp amendment to the committee amendments.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 526 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The DeCamp amendment to the committee amendment is adopted. Now we are back to the committee amendment. Do you have anything further on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are back to the committee amendment. Senator DeCamp, did you wish to handle that? The call is raised.

SENATOR DECAMP: Just move they be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the bill? I don't see any lights. Senator Schmit, do you wish to talk about the committee amendments?

SENATOR SCHMIT: No, I do not, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Senator Labedz, did you wish to talk about the committee amendments? Okay. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
