

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments as amended are adopted. Senator DeCamp, back to the bill now. Senator DeCamp, you have some amendments. Do you wish to take those up now?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to amend the bill. Those amendments are on page 433 of the Journal.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to amend the bill. Senator, I understand then you have an amendment to your own amendment, right?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yeah, so put them together. Can you do them both at the same time? Because they go as a package and I'll explain the whole thing. I don't think there will be disagreement on these, there may be on the bill, but...
