

to adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I see what you're talking about. On the second page it still refers to 14 and, of course, that should have been changed to 11, so that is what your amendment does.

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on what Senator DeCamp is doing? Okay, the question is the adoption of this amendment which will automatically void the other amendment. Right, Senator DeCamp? All right. The question is the adoption of the latest DeCamp amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment. (Vote appears on page 528 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: The last DeCamp amendment is adopted. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson is insisting that I publicly acknowledge that it was he who caught the error and not me, and I have publicly acknowledged that.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to amend.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, Senator Goll and I have checked the amendment. It was correct the first time. The numbers 12 and 13 refer to section numbers in the bill. It does not refer to percentages. Senator Johnson did not find this error or lack of error. Senator Goll and I both stand here covered with chagrin and acknowledge neither of us read the amendment. Is that right, Senator Goll? Okay. I'd like to spread the credit around. The amendment is correct as it stands.
