

All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Debate has ceased. Senator Howard Lamb, please, for closing.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members, it has been suggested, of course, that this is a Lincoln Chamber of Commerce bill and get everybody in here to do their Christmas shopping. However, I don't believe that. I don't believe that, but I do believe that you are going to be...you are going to be more unhappy than you think you are if this does pass. There has been some discussion that we should have all the bill introduction before the Christmas recess and I am not sure that would work either because by the time people get back here in January they are going to want to introduce some more bills. I think you are going to have more bills introduced under this proposal even if you split it up, if you have...I think as the resolution states, you have two days of...or the proposal now is you would have some bill introduction beforehand, before the Christmas vacation and then more afterwards. Either way, either way you are going to have more bills introduced. I don't think that the people out there in the state are interested in us doing a lot more things. The thing I hear about most is that too many bills are introduced. The Legislature is trying to do too many things for too many people and that this will just be another step in that direction. In fact, it is a step toward...could be considered a step toward a year-round Legislature and I don't think the people are ready for that. I would ask that the resolution be indefinitely postponed.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the closing. All those in favor of indefinitely postponing the resolution vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 24 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The resolution is not indefinitely postponed. Senator Haberman, we are back talking about the bill.
