PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 49? If not, the motion is to advance the bill to Enrollment and Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 49. Please record your vote. Have you all recorded your vote? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 49.

PRESIDENT: LB 49 is advanced. LB 263.

CLERK: Mr. President, 263 was a bill offered by Senator Pappas. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 17, referred to the Government Committee for hearing. It was advanced to General File, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Pappas. May we have order now, please. (Gavel.) Let's hear the words of our leader.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. President, colleagues, I think Senator Beutler has an amendment for this. Senator Beutler, Senator Beutler.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to explain the bill first, or...Do you want to explain the bill?

SENATOR PAPPAS: Okay, basically what the bill does is provide for an audit, that was inadvertently left out a few years ago, for the monies that the Crime Commission sends back to the counties that have Indian reservations on them, so somebody is accountable for the dollars they send back. The bill is needed very badly because of some discrepancies that showed up this year. Senator Beutler has an amendment for it, which I am agreeable to.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes...Do you have the amendment, Mr. Clerk?
