

SENATOR HEFNER: This is just a temporary solution for one year.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, I understand now that the introducers are in agreement, and if that is the case, then I assume the interpretation that would be given to the bill in 1986 would be as they intended, and in which case I will withdraw the amendment, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is withdrawn and we will proceed with the Final Reading of LB 30. All members are to be in your seats please. The Clerk will proceed with the reading of the bill. May we have order in the Chamber, attention to the Clerk so you can understand his words on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 30 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 573 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very well, a majority of 33 or more having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Next is LB 41.

CLERK: (Read LB 41 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 574 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of 33 or more having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. LB 51.
