SENATOR HABERMAN: Second question, as Chairman of the Revenue Committee, would you please find out why it would take the Revenue Department \$15,000 to rewrite the fuels program? That seems a little ridiculous but thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I could give an answer to that, I guess.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? Is there further discussion on LB 272A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 272A.

PRESIDENT: LB 272A is advanced. Next is LB 323A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 323A is a bill offered by Senator Lynch. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Lynch. May we have order in the Chamber please. (Gavel.) Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this bill provides the funding necessary income more than anything for the carrying out of LB 323 which is the Uniform Substance Act.

PRESIDENT: Further discussion on the bill? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 323A.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That completes the A bills. Next we go to General File, LB 113.
