

and last of the substantive provisions in areas that are covered. With regard to all four of these areas, when we went to set the penalties, we went over to the traditional sections of the statute that dealt with theft, that dealt with vandalism, that dealt with confidentiality, and with trespassing and we picked out the penalties and tried to make them exactly parallel to the penalties in those traditional sections of law so that we didn't end up with a situation where theft in one case was one kind of penalty and theft with a computer was another kind of penalty. I think to the best of our ability the severity of the penalties parallels what presently exist in our statutes for the same type of offenses. Okay, I think that is it. I would be glad to invite questions and I hope I can answer them.
