

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the bill?  
Senator Barrett.

SPEAKER BARRETT: A question of Senator Hannibal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes. Senator Hannibal.

SENATOR BARRETT: Senator Hannibal, did you divide your amendment? I'm sorry, I wasn't keeping up with you.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: No, I did not. I left them all together because I didn't...I was originally going to divide it and then decided against that because it appeared that we didn't have a need to divide it.

SENATOR BARRETT: We're going from 18 to 12 and 12 to 6 and then you refer to the inactive sections?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: That's correct.

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. President, I suppose I would want to say at this point, I have discussed this with Senator Hannibal, I'm not totally enchanted with the reduction of 18 to 12. I think the commission...if continuing education is to be meaningful, I think we've got to have some standards. On the other hand, Senator Hannibal has been very good about discussing this with several people, including myself, and at this point I would just urge the members to support the Hannibal amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Senator Hannibal, will you yield to a question, please?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Certainly.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I'm okay, except I heard a reference to 6 from Senator Barrett here and I thought...6 what?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The bill has a distinction between the first two-year period after you receive your license and all ensuing two-year periods.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Right.
