

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The idea is, after you've just gotten your license, your need for continuing education is much less. So the bill says right now that the first two-year period after you've gotten your license you only have to take 12 hours continuing education. Every other two-year period you have to take 18 hours. I'm reducing both of those amounts, the first two-year period down to 6; every other two-year period to 12.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Oh, okay. And then the going from inactive to active is 12 also?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Then the inactive to active, to reactivate would be 12 hours, that's correct.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Fine, that's my understanding of it and I just wanted to make sure I was still on the vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion on the Hannibal amendment? Did you wish to close on it, Senator Hannibal? The question is the adoption of the Hannibal amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Hannibal's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Hannibal amendment is adopted. Anything else on it?

CLERK: Nothing further at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We're back to the bill. Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: I would move the bill as amended be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? Senator Hannibal, your light is on. Did you wish to talk. Senator Hannibal, your light is on. Did you wish to speak?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. Speaker, I don't want to belabor the point. I am going to support the bill. I have been convinced that we do need this particular bill to not jeopardize our reciprocity opportunities with the
