

PRESIDENT: The motion before us is the advancement of LB 432. Members may call your vote into the Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Barrett voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senators Lamb and Warner, the house is under call. Please return to the Chamber. We are on the search for Senators Warner and Lamb. Sergeants will see what you can do about finding those two senators. The house remains under call. Senators Lamb and Warner are asked to return to the Chamber. Senators Lamb and Warner, the house is under call, your presence is requested in the Legislative Chamber. The motion, Senator Lamb, is the advancement of LB 432. You may call in your vote to the Clerk, if you wish to vote. Senator Warner, the Chair requests you to return to the Chamber. The house is under call.

CLERK: Senator Lamb voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner is the only member missing. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Senator Warner is last on the roll call, almost, so maybe he will get here by that time. I'd like to ask for a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT: Very well. Members will please come to order (gavel), for an oral roll call vote, so the Clerk will be able to hear the votes, please.

SENATOR WESELY: Can you state the motion again, Pat.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 432, which has been discussed on the floor this morning. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 619 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The bill does not advance. We move to LB 89. Matters for the record, Mr. Clerk. Excuse me. Call of the house is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Revenue, whose
