

would be taken up at the same time LB 38 would be taken up. Both bills were advanced on the same day, but amendments had to be prepared to both bills. It took longer to prepare the amendment to LB 38 than to LB 712. LB 38, just this morning, got reported out of committee with the amendments. So it is premature to take up LB 712. I would ask that it be laid over.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, that is agreed on. LB 712 and 38 will probably be taken up somewhere around the first of March.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner said that he was expecting something on 36, as I recall. Senator Warner, do you have that amendment? All right, we will pass over 36 until such time as he does have it then. We will go to LB 498.

CLERK: Mr. President, 498, offered by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 22 of this year for the first time, referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Judiciary.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Are you going to take the amendments, Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, yes. I would like to tell the members of the Legislature that you might listen to this bill because it would provide the basis for a Cecil B. DeMille production rivaling the "Ten Commandments." I think you ought to be aware, from the beginning, of what is discussed so I won't have to repeat anything. Now there are advance opinions, from the Supreme Court, published as little pamphlets, they are called advance sheets. What we are doing is increasing the number of these available to certain individuals who have a right to them. The other provision deals with statutes. We are increasing the number of statutes that the Attorney General's office can obtain so that the lawyers don't have to fight and tumble over each other in order to have access to these books. We increased the number that are available to the Legislature. You'll see one set on the table under the balcony to my left, whichever direction by the compass that would be. That is what the bill really does. Since some of these provisions had to be accomplished through committee amendments I'm
