CLERK: Senator, you will be happy to know that you received 26 votes on adoption of your committee amendments.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you very much.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted at least.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I am gratified. I am now renewing the motion that the bill be advanced. I made reference to two distinguished personages, one Mr. Cecil B. DeMille, the other the author of the "Ten Commandments." Whichever one was offended by what I said and caused the machine to malfunction, I offer my sincerest apologies and promise not to do the same thing again.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the bill? If not, the question is the advancement of LB 498. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.
