

next item, number six, Senator Wesely's report.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to approve the appointments as made by the Governor and reviewed by the Public Health and Welfare Committee on the appointments of Margaret Connealy and Shirley Vickers. That report is found on page 626 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. President, and members, the Public Health and Welfare Committee did meet and hear testimony regarding the appointments of Margaret Connealy and Shirley Vickers to the Foster Care Review Board. Both were advanced by the committee and we ask for your confirmation of their nomination. I don't know if Senator Vickers wants to confirm our feeling that Shirley Vickers, in particular, is worthy of this appointment, but we all feel that way in the committee so we would ask your support.

PRESIDENT: Is there any nepotistic statement available? Any further discussion on the confirmation report as explained by Senator Wesely? If not, the motion is to confirm the committee report on those two appointments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the approval of the confirmation report as submitted by the Public Health and Welfare Committee. (See pages 640-41 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The committee report and recommendation is approved. Do you have any matters for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Not at this time, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We go into General File and by agreement of the Speaker with other members, we will pass over LB 288 and take up LB 89. Senator Marsh is gone. Pass over 89 temporarily. LB 233.
