

this point, I think all levels of government are going to have their revenues affected by the severe financial problem that we have confronting us. That is the reason that we voted to send a delegation to Washington. That is the reason that we are having all of the publicity that is being given to the farm problem because it is a problem and this problem is reaching over into our cities and contrary to some of the economists on the national and state level...

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR HARRIS: ...it will continue to reach further into our local communities that are outside of the directly affected agricultural area. And this is one of the things that we can do for the employees of the public sector of the State of Nebraska without a great cost to the State of Nebraska. So I would urge you to support this bill. Let's advance it and then we will propose our amendment that we are going to submit on Select File. Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 353.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 353 from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the advancement of LB 353 from General File to Enrollment and Review for review. Please record your vote. The Clerk will record.
