

PRESIDENT: The Beutler amendment is adopted. We are back to the committee amendment as amended. There are lights...there are no further lights. Do you have any further comment on...Senator Warner. Senator DeCamp, do you have any more comment on the committee amendments?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, Mr. President. I believe that...I believe we have to make some other changes in the bill to comport with what Senator Beutler is attempting to do. Really, I do know a little bit about...more than I suggested, and we have to...his only started to make the amendment, you have to do some additional amendments. What I would suggest is that we advance the bill to Select File, you trust me to get with Senator Beutler despite the peril and we get the other amendments to clear up all the things on title insurance so there isn't the confusion, because I think if we do it piecemeal here at this time, you might miss one, you might gain one. I would just commit to make sure we get them corrected on Select if that is okay.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the committee amendments as amended? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, just if I could clarify what John...you are saying, John, that you are committed to separating out from the bill all vague references that might include in the bill title insurance commitments or policies? Is that what you are saying?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes. In other words, I am going on the attitude and approach that basically abstracters, it isn't intended to deal with title insurance and will clarify that.

PRESIDENT: Is there anything further on the committee amendments as amended? The motion is to adopt the Banking Committee amendments to LB 47. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion before the house is the adoption of the Banking Committee amendments as amended to LB 47. Please record your vote. Your vote is requested aye or nay on the committee amendments to LB 47. The Clerk will record the vote.
