

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 193 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall LB 193 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record your vote on LB 193. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 662 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Next, LB 240.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 240 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 240 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 663 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 240 is declared passed. Next, the Clerk will read LB 249.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Began reading LB 249 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: (Response inaudible.)

PRESIDENT: Is there objection to passing over LB 249 at this time? Hearing none, so ordered. Passing over 249. Next, LB 272. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: LB 272 now has an A bill attached to it and the A bill I think is on Select File. Under the rules of the road LB 272 should not be read until after all the main line appropriation bills are passed. So I think it should be held up to be truthful with you.
