

Mr. President, your Committee on Education, whose Chairman is Senator Vickers, reports LB 415 advanced to General File, LB 679 indefinitely postponed. Both of those signed by Senator Vickers. (See page 684 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have reports from the Retirement Actuarial Valuation of the following retirement systems. That will be on file in my office. Those retirement systems include the School Retirement System, Patrolmen's Retirement System, the Nebraska Judges Retirement System, State Employees Retirement System, and the County Employees Retirement System.
