

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes.

SENATOR BARRETT: ...calls for the filing...the docket date, the clock starts running at that point.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Well you know, Senator Barrett, Senator...

SENATOR BARRETT: I am confused. I am trying to point out that a lot of other people are too.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: You would not be confused if Senator DeCamp had been on the floor when this thing first came up.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Did you want to debate that?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: The Conway amendment strikes the committee amendment. But you've got to do this procedurally. You've got to adopt the Conway amendment, then you've got to adopt the stricken committee amendment to get the Conway amendment attached to the bill.

SENATOR BARRETT: And as an alternative you might pass the Conway amendment to the amendment and then defeat the committee amendment.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: You could if you wanted to, that would not be a wise choice.

SENATOR BARRETT: We have some procedural problems, it would occur to me. Finally, Mr. President...Thank you, Senator Johnson. The amendment to the Standing Committee amendment, as was just passed out, the first part I have no problem with. But the second part refers to on page 2, line 11. Are we not referring to the bill itself? I would ask for a ruling of the Chair.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Just a minute please. Senator Barrett, what is your specific question, please?

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. President, in the printed material just handed out the amendment to the Standing Committee amendment, number one, we are apparently addressing the amendment. But, number two, are we not referring to the bill itself where it is suggested that on page 2, line 11,
