Members in the Chamber, record your presence and two members are excused this morning. Members, please record your presence. The house is under call. All members outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. A call of the house is now taking place. You may call in your vote to the Clerk if you wish on the...no, you don't want that, Senator? He's asking for a roll call.

SENATOR VICKERS: I'd like a roll call vote. I want to make sure everybody is here though. How many are excused?
