

Several reports from the Department of Roads to include a map or copy of the Nebraska Roads Highways and Streets designated as federal aid primary roads as of January 1, 1985. I have a second report from Roads, a third report from Roads, a fourth report from Roads and a Minutes of the Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards. All of those will be on file in my office, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 56. Are we ready to plunge into LR 58?

PRESIDENT: Can we have order in the Chamber, please. (Gavel.) Order in the Chamber.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 58 was a resolution offered by Senators Vickers and Beutler. (Read LR 58.) Mr. President, that resolution is on page 782 of the Journal. As you will recall, it was considered by the Legislature on Friday, March 1.

PRESIDENT: This measure was bracketed until today and the Chair would like to announce that we will begin a completely new speaking list for this matter today. The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler. May we have order, please. (Gavel.) Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, we are back on resolution 58 and, as you will recall, that particular resolution basically simply encourages the House of Representatives and the President to pass into law certain amendments that have been approved by the United States Senate and will be, hopefully, voted upon and approved by the House of Representatives today or tomorrow, all of which deal, of course, with the immediate ag problem which is the farm credit problem. Those particular amendments that are being proposed to ease the ag credit situation essentially deal with three areas. One of those areas is the area of FMHA loan guarantees and related to that although a separate item is the area of allowing interest buy downs on classified loans. And the third area is the commodity credit program and the making available of
