

that. We passed resolutions supporting it. And if, obviously, you had a line item veto, that would be possible to allow that part and not the other part. But I think he can do that. The President can do that portion by administrative action and the legislation reaching there would certainly be an indication that we want it done at least at a minimum by administrative action. I don't believe it is appropriate at least at this time for this Legislature to say, absolutely don't veto this legislation, Mr. President, absolutely don't veto it. And so we are saying instead of that by my amendment if you were to adopt it, look at the whole picture, give it a second thought, carefully consider it and recognize, Mr. President, that back here we are really concerned. For that reason, I urge you to adopt the amendment and if that amendment were adopted, I would be one of those supporting the resolution instead of opposing it.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the DeCamp amendment to LB 58 (sic). All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the DeCamp amendment to resolution 58. Please record your vote. The Chair will allow 20 seconds for the recording of vote. Motion before the house is the adoption of the DeCamp amendment to resolution 58. Please record your vote if you wish to vote.
