PRESIDENT: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, LB 293 is introduced to clarify the existing law in the State of Nebraska as to the augmented estate. The bill defines bona fide purchaser as used in the legislation and changes the deadline for filing of the petition for the elective share to coincide with the date on which the federal estate tax return must be filed with the United States government. I urge this body to advance LB 293. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler, do you wish to speak on this measure? Anyone else that wishes to speak on LB 293? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 293. Please record your vote. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to advance LB 293.

PRESIDENT: LB 293 is advanced. Senator Beutler, can you work yours in in three minutes?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Depends on the vote of the body, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: Well, why...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead, Senator Beutler. Well, the Clerk will read it first.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 40 offered by Senator Beutler. (Read title.) It was first read on January 10, referred to the Government Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
