CLERK: I think, Senator, given their different entities, perhaps it would be better to two separate motions. If that is agreeable with you.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. So at this time I move that we accept Lucy Buntain to a member of the Nebraska Arts Council.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the recommendation of Senator Hefner? I believe that name is Lucy Buntain. All those in favor of the committee confirmation report vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the confirmation report.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation...committee report of confirmation is approved by the Legislature. For your information, we have a Mother of the Year ceremony this morning which the Speaker hopes will get underway about ten forty-five. If the Clerk has anything to read into the record he may do it. Oh, excuse me, I didn't realize that, Senator Hefner. Go ahead.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee met awhile back to discuss the appointment of two members to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission. The first one was Ronald R. Volkmer of Omaha, and Gary L. Tesar of North Platte. The committee voted unanimously to accept these two Governor appointments. So I move that the body, here this morning, accept these to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion? If not, the report and recommendation of the committee is up for your approval. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the approval of Senator Hefner's committee recommendation for confirmation of an appointment. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.
