LB 313A, 391A

PRESIDENT: The confirmation report is approved and adopted. Again, we will go to the Mother of the Year ceremony approximately at nine forty-five, according to the Speaker's agenda. Do you have matters for the record? All right. We will move to the two A bills, first, on Final Reading. As soon as members are in your seats...Is Senator Wesely around? We might move to General File and take up some A bills first. We'll go...to take up the time we will go to General File and take up a couple of A bills, LB 253A, LB 313A, excuse me.

CLERK: Mr. President, 313A was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President and members, LB 313 deals with licensure standards for mobile homes and recreational vehicles. I believe all of this money is...I believe it is all cash fund. It is that bill that we need to have in order to comply with the federal statutes. So we do need LB 313. This does not have any general fund money. I'd ask for its advancement.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 313A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the advancement from General File to Enrollment and Review of LB 313A. Please record your vote on the advancement from General File of LB 313A. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 313A.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Next, LB 391A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 391A, offered by Senator Wesely. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: This is a \$1,600 cash fund bill, no general funds, to implement 391. That is that comprehensive health insurance pool bill.
