

now go to General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill on General File is LB 43. It was a bill introduced by Senator Warner. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 10, referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Government Committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis, are you taking those committee amendments?

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. LB 43 is the bill on compensation, is it not, for constitutional officers. The amendment that was brought to me was for the purpose of clarifying dates against which the salary increases for the Public Service Commission would run. We had used different dates in the bill. In the amendments I think we had used not January but July because there had been a previous change at those dates. They are not the beginning of terms for Public Service officers, and for that reason we needed to change the dates in which they run. So the amendments that were printed in the Journal simply begin the Public Service Commission salary increases at the appropriate times, at the beginning of the upcoming terms of office that those would fall against. I move for the adoption of that amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis, that is the amendment to the committee amendments, right?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes. Should I be talking about the committee amendments first?

SPEAKER NICHOL: No, that is okay. Are you through with the amendment to the committee amendment?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes. That is the amendment to the committee amendment. I will explain the committee amendments following the adoption of this technical amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Fine. Any other discussion on the amendment to the committee amendment? If not, the question
