SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I want to answer Senator Haberman's question. He says why the large fiscal impact of four hundred and some thousand. This is when the bill had services in yet. So they figured that if they had to get that list of companies that provided services they would need more money and so this is why it was so high. The fiscal impact at the present time is less than \$200,000 and they think that it will be lower than that. They're still working on that, so I just wanted to tell Senator Haberman about this and get it into the record. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
