CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Beutler. Senator, this is Request 285. (The Beutler amendment appears on page 875 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, Mr. Speaker and members of the public, members of the Legislature, members of the public, whoever is interested.

PRESIDENT: That's broad enough to include us all.

SENATOR BEUTLER: This particular amendment is on page 17, line 7.

CLERK: It is page 7, line 17, I think, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'm sorry, I have it backwards. Page 7, line 17, right. Okay and I hope that you will pay attention to this one because this is one that was not agreed upon and there will be two amendments that relate to this particular section of the bill and involve some small policy decisions, decisions that are nonetheless important in this particular area. This particular section of the bill has to do with the board and who is going to compose this Board of Examiners for registered abstracters. And prior to this time the board had two members who were attorneys and three members who were registered abstracters, and now they are changing it and under the bill in the green copy the board would have three members who are abstracters, one member who is a lawyer, instead of two, and that member would also have to be an abstracter, and then one member from the public. Okay, the amendment that is before you at this moment in time would say with regard to the member who is from the public that that person should be knowledgeable in real estate transactions. In other words, instead of asking the Governor just to appoint any member of the Governor, he would ask the Governor to seek out a person who is knowledgeable in real estate transactions.
