SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Now then I have some...any further discussion on this proposal? Any closing, Senator Beutler? Motion is to adopt the Beutler amendment as proposed and been under discussion. All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Beutler amendment to LB 47. Please record your vote. May we have the cooperation of the Legislature on this matter on Select File to record your vote aye or nay on the Beutler amendment to LB 47. Please record your vote. The motion before you is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 47. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Would members...have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Did you say nothing "futher" on the bill?

CLERK: Either way.

PRESIDENT: Senator...have the E & R amendments all been adopted and everything? Senator Beutler, do you want to move it? Senator Warner, excuse me.

SENATOR WARNER: I would be pleased to have anybody move the bill. Or everyone. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 47 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 614.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 614 I have E & R amendments.
