

which would provide a process to be handled by virtue of there being an expired or a stolen credit card. I would like to think that the average person moving down the interstate probably would not use a stolen card to pay for a traffic fine as he traverses across the state, but in the event of an expired or an overline limit card that should not have been accepted, I think that is certainly appropriate for the process.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Goodrich, it is time to close on your amendment. Closing has been waived. The motion is the adoption of the Goodrich amendment to the Vickers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. A simple majority. Is there anybody else that cares to vote? We are about to record. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays in adopting Senator Goodrich's amendment to Senator Vickers' amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The amendment is adopted. We are now back on the Vickers amendment. Senator Hoagland, I understand you want to speak on that amendment. Senator Hoagland, if I may before you begin, Senator Miller has asked us to greet today his guests under the south balcony of the Legislature from Upland, Nebraska and Minden, Nebraska, from Upland, Don Miller, Orlan Grams, and Bill Koch, and from Minden, Robert Christensen, DuWayne Krueger, Tony Miller, and Gene Lundeen. Welcome to the Legislature. Please stand and be recognized. Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. President and colleagues, let me state frankly I am quite concerned about this amendment and would like to address Senator Conway and Senator Vickers just briefly, and let me, while Senator Conway is approaching his microphone, let me indicate what my concern is. As I read this amendment, it requires the courts to take personal checks in payment of fines and the problem with that, of course, is that a lot of people have insufficient funds in their checking accounts. There is always the possibility of stopping a check after you make the payment in court and I wonder if Senator Conway and Senator Vickers would agree to an amendment on Select File that would adequately protect the courts by giving them line discretion not to accept a personal check if they think a personal check should not be accepted so that we don't have to deal with the issue today and can move on to other
