

particularly the amendment to the amendment and possibly on Select we will bring that amendment back dealing with some clearing process to make sure that those credit cards are valid instruments when they are accepted by the State Patrol. But it should, and the support of the State Patrol was based on the fact that it does allow them a lot more time on the road rather than the lost time in taking that individual into a community and getting a money order or various other guaranteed instruments to be tied with the citation so that they are processing their waiver, and by so doing, we would possibly be able to save a lot more man-hours of the State Patrol out on the roadway where they would like to be rather than running back and forth to communities. So I think the bill started out to be the usual innocuous little bill that I think has some value to the state in terms of the creation of a smoother operation for the patrol and also a bit of revenue gain for the state by virtue of the interest procurement that we didn't have prior to. So the bill as it stands now I think is worthy of advancement and I highly recommend the body so doing.
