CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to your seats and record your presence. Many of you are already in your seats and you just as well punch your little green button now. Thank you. We're looking for Senator Higgins, Senator Sieck, Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, Senator Higgins and Senator Sieck. Senator Higgins is here. We're looking for only Senator Chambers at the moment. Senator Johnson, did you wish to wait for Senator Chambers?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Oh, no, I don't think I want to inconvenience the body. Why don't you just go ahead and call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Roll call vote. We are voting on the amendment on Section 5. Mr. Clerk.
