That would allow us to meet sometime between December 1 and December 7, depending on when the election day is. So we would meet the first week of December. Under the original proposal it was the second week of December, so we get away from the Christmas argument now. We're going to meet the first week of December and it should work out well. I'd ask your vote in advancement.
