LB 292

LB 292 offered by Senator Beutler. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Twenty-five votes required. Please record your vote. It's the Beutler amendment to LB 292. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Abboud would move to amend. (Abboud amendment appears on page 927 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR ABOUD: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I have an amendment here that was given to me by the bill drafter's office. These amendments are technical in nature, provides for two technical changes. First, the first section, it describes this as the uniform durable power of attorney and then the second section makes it clear that the new sections of the law are part of the Nebraska probate code for reference matters. In the front of the table of Chapter XXX it will specify that this deals with the Nebraska probate code and it also makes it compatible with LB 293. I would appreciate the advancement of this amendment on LB 292. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the Abboud amendment to the bill? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment as explained. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.
