

Other people realize that. I do have an A bill which you will see follows LB 38 on the agenda today. There may have to be amendments to that bill. I have been in conversation with the Revenue Department and I have here a little note. We just visited today. They requested a conversation with me this morning and two representatives of the Revenue Department were over here and they are working on how this would be implemented and they are coming up with ideas as to how to make it cheaper. They are working on it diligently and I have a handwritten note here, a suggestion for an amendment which looks to me like it would be...all it says is that the County Treasurer shall file monthly a statement as to the property taxes paid in the county. They are working on this amendment. This may or may not be ready today. I don't think it will be ready today but I am sure it will be ready for Select File.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the amendment to the amendment? Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Mr. President. Would Senator Lamb yield to a question, please?

SENATOR LAMB: Yes.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Senator Lamb, you said the county treasurers would file a report with the Department of Revenue every month? I am not sure I understood what you were saying.

SENATOR LAMB: Well, I am only saying there are discussions as to exactly how the bill would be implemented and that has been one suggestion. That has not been adopted, not even...we don't even have an amendment. But the Revenue Department is working on methods to most efficiently administer the bill and I just used that as one example of some of the things that they are thinking about at this point.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Would they be figuring then the cost to the various counties to do that?

SENATOR LAMB: Yes, that will be taken into consideration. And, of course, it is my purpose to not cause undue burdens on the counties and also the amendment which I have just offered would remove burdens from the state because I am
