

the sales tax on motor vehicles is a very reasonable way to do that. I think, as a matter of fact, in all probability when we appropriate money for the State Department of Roads this year it will not be at the level requested because the gas tax will just get too high and so you need some other sources of revenue going in there. I would urge the body to retain that concept that we have had now for a number of years with those funds going back to the state and the cities and the counties for road purposes. That is property tax relief too, certainly at the county and the city level, because what they fail to receive in funds from the highway trust fund, they obviously have to make up with local property taxes. So I would urge the body to adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the Warner amendment to the Revenue Committee amendments. Simple majority is sufficient. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record your vote on the Warner amendment to the Revenue Committee amendments to LB 38, aye or nay. Senator Johnson. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Please record your vote on the Warner amendment to the Revenue Committee amendments on LB 38. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The amendment fails. Do you have another amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Arlene Nelson. Senator Nelson would move to amend. Essentially, if I may, Senator, it is striking the 30 percent and inserting 25 and a cap of \$500. Is that right? Okay.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Arlene Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: Mr. President, that amendment is correct. Change it to 20 percent and a maximum of \$500 cap. Now I would also suggest, would it be possible that we could leave this at this point and give us time this afternoon or something to get more closer projections from the Revenue Department so that we can see approximately what this cap will do? And we all realize this is not going to work
