

Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner who is Chairman of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee reports on the appointment of Mr. Jon McCafferty to the State Electrical Board. Senator Hefner's report is found on page 919 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move for the approval of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee confirmation report. This is Jon K. McCafferty to the State Electrical Board. He was appointed by Governor Kerrey. The Miscellaneous Subjects Committee held a hearing on March 7 and unanimously approved this report.
