SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 252 passes. We're going to go back to LB 116 with the emergency clause attached now and the amendment that was proposed will not be offered, so we will continue with 116E at this time.

CLERK: Senator, I understand you wish to withdraw the amendment. Okay. (Read LB 116 on Final Reading.)
