LB 67, 104, 191, 223

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 954-955 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 223 is declared passed. LB 191.

CLERK: (Read LB 191 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 191 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 955-956 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 1 nay, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. LB 67.

CLERK: (Read LB 67 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 67 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The board has been cleared and there is a malfunction in the machine. Would you please vote again. The question is aye or nay on LB 67 for final passage. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 956-957 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority voting in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We're skipping over LB 94 and passing to LB 104.

CLERK: (Read LB 104 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record the vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.
