LB 299, 407, 446, 498

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 960 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 6 nays, 1 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is declared passed. Next we have LB 446 with the emergency clause.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 446 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 960-961 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 46 ayes, 1 nay, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Next we go to Final Reading for LB 498.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 498 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 498 pass? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Please record your vote on LB 498. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 961-962 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The majority vote in the affirmative is sufficient and the bill is declared passed. Do you have matters for the record at this time, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir, I do not.

PRESIDENT: With special order is the undertaking of LB 407. Is Senator Wesely aboard?
