

PRESIDENT: Very well. Read the motion and its sponsor.

CLERK: Senator Wesely would move to suspend Rule 6, Section 3, Rule 7, Section 3, and vote without further debate and without further amendment on the advancement of LB 407.

PRESIDENT: The vote will be taken on the suspension of the rules which will take 30 votes. Then we will proceed to the vote on the bill. The motion is to suspend the rules. Vote aye or nay. We did, we did have a request for a roll call. I have been up here too long this morning. Record the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Commenced reading the roll call vote.)

PRESIDENT: (Gavel.) Can we have quiet in the Chamber, please.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 965 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails and we are back to the bill. There is an amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marsh would move to amend the bill. Senator Marsh would move to add a new section which would read, "The provisions of this act shall terminate on July 1, 1987".

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I will make it very short so that there is time for a vote on this and a vote to advance the bill. The purpose is for us to take a look after we have seen the agency in action.

PRESIDENT: The call of the house is raised. Excuse me.

SENATOR MARSH: I move for the adoption of the amendment which adds a sunset clause. We would then have a chance to look at it again and I urge your adoption of this proposed amendment to LB 407.

PRESIDENT: You have heard Senator Marsh's motion to amend the bill. Senator Beutler, do you wish to speak?
