

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. President. We've talked about the high school teams. This is a college team that we're all behind in Nebraska, the University of Nebraska women's swim team. They won the Big Eight Championship for the first time this year. They joined their male colleagues who have been consistently winning the Big Eight since Cal Bentz came on as coach and we congratulate the men's team as well, but the women's team is kind of special because this is their first time. We hope that they'll have a tradition just like the men's team and continue winning that Big Eight championship, so I ask your support for the resolution and recognition of their achievements.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely. Is there further discussion? If not, all those in favor of the resolution as introduced by Senator Wesely vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record your vote on LR 73 introduced by Senator Wesely. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: LR 73 is adopted, Mr. President, with 31 ayes, and 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted. May I have your attention? The Clerk has two more resolutions that will require suspension of rules. May we have your attention on his reading them.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 74 offered by Senator Goll congratulates the Arlington boys basketball team for being champions of Class C-1. Senator DeCamp would offer LR 75 for the Clearwater boys basketball team for winning the Class D-1 basketball championship. First of all, Mr. President, in order to consider those today we would need to suspend the rules.

PRESIDENT: The motion would have to be now to suspend the rules and take up the resolution today and is it, Senator Goll? Senator Goodrich? Senator Goll. Go ahead, Senator Goll.

SENATOR GOLL: Mr. President and members, I would move that we suspend the rules that we might take up these two resolutions.
