

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Remmers voting no. Senator Nelson voting no. Senator Pirsch voting yes. Senator Lamb voting no.

PRESIDENT: Please call in your vote to the Clerk if you wish to take a position on the motion to advance LB 215. You may call in your vote to the Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting yes. Senator Hartnett voting yes. Senator Eret voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Someone press Senator Chambers' button, he is present. Senator Goodrich, did you ask for a roll call? First we'll determine if we have our members present here under a call of the house. Senator Chambers, record your presence, please. Senator Hartnett, Senator Scofield. It appears that all 46 members are present, that three members are excused. If you will be quiet, the Clerk will call the roll. The motion is to advance LB 215 to Enrollment and Review for review. Call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 994 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill advances. We move now...do you have any matters for the record?

CLERK: No, sir.

PRESIDENT: We move now to LB..., Clerk, 569, what is the situation on that? Are we going to pass over that? I believe we are passing over 569. We move to LB 335.

CLERK: Mr. President, 335 was a bill introduced by Senators Goodrich, Goll, Lowell Johnson and Lundy. (Read title.) It was read on January 17, referred to the Banking Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President and members of the body, the purpose of this particular bill is the fact that we have got some people in institutions that...I want to make sure I am explaining the right bill here. Okay, it is the patient
