CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 606.

PRESIDENT: LB 606 is advanced. LB 308.

CLERK: 308 offered by Senator Schmit. (Read title.) It was read on January 17, referred to the Public Works Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Loran Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the bill is a very simple bill. It allows the rural fire districts to contract with public power districts. The language in the rural fire district law is very specific and it is very limited as to the specific areas that they can operate in. There are some instances, for example, at Gentleman Station where if there were a need for fire protection, they couldn't even provide that in that area. So it is permissive legislation and it is very needed. I would hope you would advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 308? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted on the advancement of LB 308? Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 308.

PRESIDENT: LB 308 is advanced. The Chair would like to announce that while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, and 73, and 74 and 75. Next is LB 146.

CLERK: Mr. President, 146 by Senators Beutler and Haberman. (Read title.) It was referred to the Judiciary Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
