

true? It hasn't generally followed that decline on its tail and as dramatically. Would you say that would be true?

SENATOR DECAMP: Well, true and false. The reason it might be false is because we never had it valued properly in the first place, therefore, it was never assessed properly. It was at about 40 percent of actual value. Follow?

SENATOR BEUTLER: In part. I guess what I am...the way I see it, in the situation where you would usually be using this, you are going to be using a standard that really has no more relationship to actual market value than...it may have no relationship to actual market value. Would you agree? Well, I guess the question I have...

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, I would say that is entirely possible.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The question I have is, why are we setting up a standard that might have no relationship to reality?

SENATOR DECAMP: Well, I guess the rest of the answer to that is this was disposed of and put out here before the decision on amendment four was done.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Do you still support this particular bill?

SENATOR DECAMP: Donald had some good ideas on this. It is Senator Eret's bill and I am sponsoring it with him and, of course, this was before amendment four.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I don't think you answered my question.

SENATOR DECAMP: I...I...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Do you think at this point in...

SENATOR DECAMP: I think I jumped your question.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Do you think at this point...

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Do you presently think at this point in time that setting up this kind of a standard is really a good idea?
