

SENATOR DECAMP: You really want me to answer.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, I would like that.

SENATOR DECAMP: No, I don't. I think the idea was good when it was proposed. I think that amendment four and what is happening there creates almost an absolute dichotomy of purpose and I think that answers it.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the bill? Senator Eret, you are entitled to close.

SENATOR ERET: The purpose of this bill was to give something to go by. We do through complete assessment of all property. We know what the information is on that but there is nothing in statute to state what the Banking Director is to use as market value. We know not where he would be getting his information for this purpose especially when there is somewhat of a volatile land market. I would urge that the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 63. All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. May we have the attention of the members, please, to the action on the floor. The motion before you is the advancement of LB 63. Please record your vote. Obviously, we would like to get to as many consent bills as possible. Please record your vote on the advancement of LB 63. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 63.

PRESIDENT: LB 63 is advanced. We are skipping over LB 691 to LB 209.

CLERK: Mr. President, 209 was a bill that was introduced by Senator Jacklyn Smith. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 15, referred to the Health Committee for hearing, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments, Mr. President. In addition, Senator Wesely, you have an amendment to the committee amendments on page 967.
