

SENATOR DECAMP: 29 is hardly enough to get going very far.

PRESIDENT: There are about ten excused who will be arriving within the next hour or so.

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay. Then I suggest we can't proceed on this bill until most of the body is here, in my opinion.

PRESIDENT: Is the Speaker around? Speaker Nichol. Speaker Nichol, it is the suggestion of Senator DeCamp that because of the lack of some ten members we can't very well proceed with 662 immediately. What is your wish on that?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, may I ask why we can't proceed, Senator DeCamp?

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, it would appear to me it is a closely divided issue and any amendments or anything else is going to be requiring the bulk of the body here. I am certainly willing to proceed, however,...

PRESIDENT: Seven members are gone at the present time.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I would suggest that we handle some of the Select File for a few minutes, then see if we don't have more people here so that it would be even (interruption)...

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay, if they want to proceed, if Senator Johnson wants to proceed, hey, I'm ready. Old John will have a vote on it right now.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Nobody has been crowding from either side that I know of, so if...

PRESIDENT: If there are some Enrollment and Review amendments to adopt, Mr. Clerk, we can proceed with those.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hall, I have no amendments on LB 313A.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 313A be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to advance the bill from
