

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 350 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to advance the bill from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Oh, excuse me. LB 326.

CLERK: Senator, I have E & R to 326.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Conway would move to amend the bill. Senator Conway's amendment is found on page 969 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Motion on the desk by Senator Conway. Do you wish to proceed, Senator?

SENATOR CONWAY: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, the amendment to 326 was simply a clarification of some of the language that was found in the amendment that was already attached during the General File. The amendment would now read, as listed in the Journal, as no account shall contain more than the amount so insured, would be added on. That is the only addition...or the only change to this bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the Conway amendment? If not, all those in favor of adopting the amendment offered by Senator Conway vote aye, opposed vote nay. We're voting on the adoption of the Conway amendment to 326. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.
